

Hyperion Treatment Plant Wins Award: Best Project of Merit for Water/Environment

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The Digester Gas Utilization Project at Hyperion Treatment Plant has won Best Project of Merit in the Water/Environment category for 2019 awarded by ENR California.

The City of Los Angeles, Bureau of Sanitation operates the Hyperion Treatment Plant that accepts all wastewater for the city and includes the largest digester gas production facility in North America.

This project, a \$127 million, 42 MW new and innovative style CHP, uses cleaned digester gas produced at the plant mixed with natural gas to provide renewable energy using turbine engines and HRSGs as the prime movers.
